Havasu Gold Seekers, Inc. is a non-profit gold seekers club in Lake Havasu City, Arizona with 15 gold bearing claims, covering over 320 acres.

The Club was started in early 1991 when a small group of Lake Havasu City residents got together for the purpose of recreational gold prospecting in the desert near Lake Havasu City, Arizona. The Club started with about 20 men and women and grew slowly until February of 1992 when Captain Dan McCarty and seven other members formed an association and filed four placer claims totaling 640 acres. At the very next club meeting the Club elected officers and adopted by-laws. The newly elected President, Dan McCarty, Vice-President, Denny Craig, and Secretary, Elaine Babb, had the tough job of making things work well for the benefit of all club members. From that point on the Club has grown to over 400 members. HGS purchased its own land near the claims for Club activities such as family outings, BB's, camping and of course, GOLD PROSPECTING!

From September through May, the Havasu Gold Seekers, Inc. meets in the Havasu Room at Quality Inn & Suites Motel on the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. The Board Meeting precedes the general meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Yearly individual or family membership dues are \$40 and are due by December 31. Family membership includes family members under 18. The initiation fee for a new membership is \$100. The total cost for new members the first year is \$140 and \$40 thereafter. The dues help us pay for club functions, miscellaneous expenses, and fees on HGS gold claims.

Anyone wishing to join the Havasu Gold Seekers must fill out a Membership Application and a Hold Harmless Agreement. Take your application and agreement to a Club meeting or mail it along with your check to:

- MEMBER'S GUEST IS NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMON DIG..
- COMMON DIG AREA IS CLOSED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FOR THE SATURDAY AND SUNDAY OF THE DIG. The area opens at the scheduled time of the dig on Saturday and closes on Sunday at sunset. COMMON DIG AREA IS CLEARLY MARKED WITH PVC PIPE AND FLAGS.

MINUTES - GENERAL MEETING

5-6-14

The meeting began at 7:05pm, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Officers present were: President Rudy Andrews, Vice President Johnn Marshall, Secretary Kim Marshall and Treasurer Norb Kiesling. **Board Members present were:** Marshall, James Rixie, Bruce Miller, and Bob Garver. There was a motion to dispense the reading of the minutes from general the last meeting and was seconded. Norb Kiesling gave the treasurers report. A motion was made and seconded to accept the treasurer's report. The new members and guests stood up and introduced themselves. Ron Marshall Andrews and Rudv announced explained that it has come to our attention that all of our claims have been revoked because as a club we do not qualify for the Small Minors Waiver Fee. We have since re-filed for the current common dig area and the claim for our next common dig area. There was some discussion on the matter. Norb had our well water tested and gave a report on it, everything came back ok except it showed positive for Coliform bacteria which is commonly found in soils, plants and animals. As a reminder it is posted that our well water is Non-Potable water but the health department is also suggesting that we not drink the water until the bacteria is cleared up. The board has




decided to purchase food grade chlorine tablets which was a recommendation of the Mohave Environmental Lab. Rudy also announced that the annual reports to the Arizona Corporation Commission and the Income taxes have both been filed. We had our 50/50 drawing which came to \$105 and the lucky winner for that was Evie Brimhall. It was brought to our attention that one of our rules was removed or just not carried over that the common digs are for members only, guests may not participate. Rudy also reminded no free food for quests as well. There was a question as to whether kids or grandkids could participate, it was noted that it is a family club and children under the age of 18 are welcome, once they turn 18 then they need to join. Of course if it's a onetime visit for a guest to participate in one of our food gatherings then a small donation would be accepted. We had our losing ticket drawing and there were 3 winners for silver coins, Gary Menser, Ron Marshall, and Neil Sitenga. Rudy announced the next meeting will be September 2nd

There was a motion made and seconded to adjourn


